





## Your Catholic Faith with Fr. Roy

### **Pakistan Flooding and Catholic Relief Services Response**

We have been receiving an increasing amount of calls from parishes asking about our Catholic church's response to the flooding in Pakistan. Catholic Relief Services has worked in Pakistan since 1954 and just before the recent flooding had 227 staff there—almost all Pakistani. CRS immediately began a response, dealing mostly with emergency shelter, food, water and hygiene needs, and is expanding on a daily basis its response in affected areas.

“Our teams are battling the weather, the terrain and the immense scale of the disaster,” says Carolyn Fanelli, Head of Programming for CRS Pakistan. “In places where water has begun to recede, it has left behind a trail of devastation.” More updated information can be found at [www.crs.org](http://www.crs.org).

In the past two days, CRS has distributed plastic sheeting, purification tablets, cookware and other items to more than 150 families in the Swat Valley. “At first, we didn't get to as many families as planned because a new landslide blocked the way—our team got stuck on one side of it, but as of Monday, August 9 we've reached more than 1,500 people. Before that, CRS distributed supplies to 4,000 people in the Kohlu and Barkhan areas of Balochistan in the southern part of the country. The rainy weather there also has make things much slower.” says Fanelli.

Millions of Pakistanis have been affected by the floods. Many have lost their homes, crops, livestock and small businesses. Once the most immediate needs are met, CRS will help farmers and others to regain their means of earning a living. In several areas including Swat, CRS is planning cash-for-work projects, paying people affected by the disaster to build irrigation channels, pathways and retaining walls.

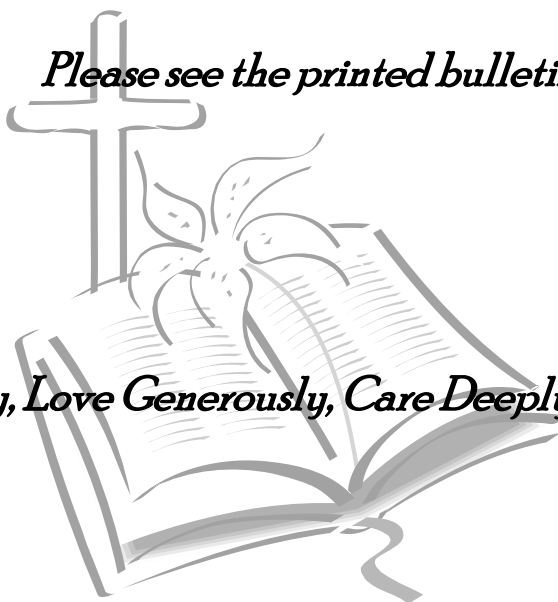

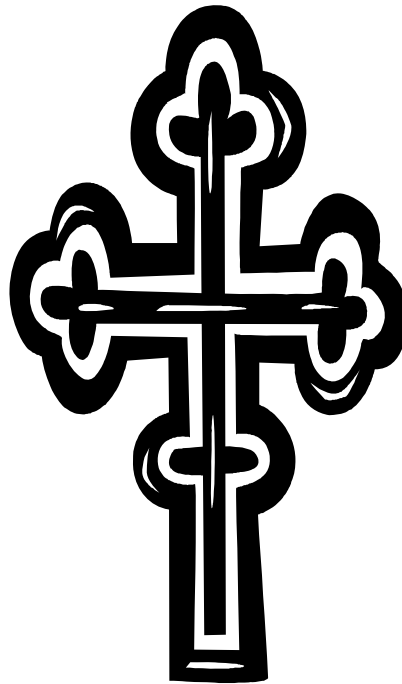
